GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Scholarship Committee is comprised of members representing the Edwards Spouses' Club.
- The applicant is responsible for ensuring all necessary information and official documents are submitted to the Scholarship Chair. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied. Answer all questions completely. Give specific dates when required. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
- 3. The Scholarship Committee reviews and determines applicant eligibility criteria.
- 4. The Scholarship Committee determines selection criteria. Criteria may include all or some of the following: academic achievement, essays, honors, athletics, community service, and work experience. Financial need is not taken into consideration.
- 5. The Scholarship Committee determines the number of scholarships to be awarded and the monetary value of each scholarship based on available funds and the analysis of scores. Submission of an application does not guarantee a scholarship.
- 6. The Scholarship Committee Chairperson and his/her dependents are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- 7. The Scholarship Committee invites individuals from the community to judge the essays. Judges and their dependents are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- 8. Awards are granted without regard to race, gender, ethnicity, religion, or disability.
- 9. Applicants will be notified in writing of the results.

- 11. All applicants must use direct communication with the Scholarship Chair through their personal email, not a school email.
- 12. Any communication or inquiries will only be directed between the ESC Scholarship Chair and the applicant. External parties will not be provided any information about the applicant or application.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must meet **ONE** of the following eligibility requirements at the time of the application deadline.

The applicant must be currently residing in the Antelope Valley area and a bona fide dependent of:

- 1. An active duty U.S. Military member currently assigned to Edwards AFB.
- 2. An active duty U.S. Military member serving a tour elsewhere.
- 3. An active duty U.S. Military member assigned to Edwards AFB, but serving a ROTC or recruiting duty elsewhere in California.
- 4. A full-time Reservist.
- 5. A full-time Federal Guardsman stationed at Edwards AFB.
- 6. A deceased U.S. Military member who was on active duty at the time of death.
- 7. A retired U.S. Military member.
- 8. An active civil service employee (DOD) at Edwards AFB.

QUALIFICATIONS

The applicant must meet **ALL** of the following qualifications:

- Has submitted applications and plans to enroll in the 2020-2021 school year at a College, University, Vocational or Technical School accredited through an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges.
- 2. Submits a completed application to the Scholarship Committee Chairperson of the Edwards Spouses' Club (ESC).

REGULATIONS/LIMITATIONS

- 1. **A completed application must be postmarked by March 15, 2020.** The ESC and the members of the Scholarship Committee are not responsible for lost or misdirected mail or applications.
- 2. Incomplete applications, or those received after the deadline, will not be accepted.
- 3. No member of the scholarship judging panel is also a member of the ESC.
- 4. Notifications of the scholarship recipients will be made in mid-April 2020. Recipients will be recognized at the A&FRC Volunteer Appreciation
- 5. Scholarship funds are to be used by 31 May 2021.
- 6. Scholarship funds awarded may be used for tuition, fees, room and board, certifications and/or books.
- 7. Funds will not be sent until the student provides proof of acceptance to a qualified program.
- 8. The scholarship award must not exceed the cost of tuition, fees, room and board, and books for the academic year. Any remaining funds must be returned to the ESC Scholarship Committee.
- 9. Students accepting an appointment to a military service academy or a **FULL** scholarship (to include tuition, fees, room and board, and books) become ineligible for this ESC scholarship award.
- 10. Students accepting the GI bill or a scholarship from another military officers'/enlisted spouses' organization that pays the **FULL** tuition, fees, room, and board, and books will be ineligible for this scholarship.

- 5. If I accept an appointment to a military service academy or a **FULL** scholarship (to include tuition, fees, room and board, and books), I will be ineligible for this ESC scholarship award.
- 6. If I receive the GI Bill or accept a scholarship from another military officers'/enlisted spouses' organization that pays **FULL** tuition, fees, room and board, and books, I will be ineligible for this ESC scholarship.
- 7. I am a responsible citizen in good standing in the school and the community.
- 8. It is my responsibility to notify the ESC Scholarship Committee of any change of status (e.g., change of schools, change in address, etc.) Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of my scholarship award.
- 9. Unclaimed funds as of 1 July 2021 revert to the ESC Scholarship Fund.
- 10. If any of the above conditions are violated, scholarship funds must be returned to the ESC Scholarship Fund.
